### 1 Title

- (1) This Notice is the Animal Products (Specifications for Products Intended for Human Consumption) Amendment Notice (No.6) 2006.
- (2) In this Notice the Animal Products (Specifications for Products Intended for Human Consumption) Notice 2004 is called the “principal notice”.

### 2 Commencement

- (1) This Notice comes into force on 30 January 2006.

### 3 Application of this Part

Clause 36A(2) of the principal notice is revoked and replaced with:

- “(2) For the purposes of this Part, farmed animals means farmed cattle, farmed deer, farmed sheep, farmed goats, farmed pigs, farmed ostriches, and farmed emus.”
