## Notice

### 1 Title

This notice is the Animal Products (National Microbiological Database Specifications) Amendment Notice 2009.

### 2 Commencement

This notice comes into force on 6 July 2009.

### 3 Principal notice

This notice amends the Animal Products (National Microbiological Database Specifications) Notice 2009 (the "principal notice").

### 4 Schedule 1 National Microbiological Database Programme

The principal notice is hereby amended by revoking the first paragraph of section 3.4.3 of Schedule 1 and replacing it with -

"Each poultry whole carcass rinse sample will be analysed for *Campylobacter*. Additional analyses are required for *Salmonella* and *E. coli* for one carcass, and for standard throughput *E. coli* for a further carcass of the set sampled that processing day. Refer section 2.10, Table 7 and section 2.12.1."

Explanatory note: This minor amendment is to clarify the requirements for poultry sampling in relation to standard throughput premises and ensure consistency within the principal notice.
