## Notice

### 1 Title

This notice is the Wine (Recognised Laboratories) Amendment Notice 2007.

### 2 Commencement

This notice comes into force on 20 April 2007.

### 3 Application

Sub clause (2) of clause 3 of the principle notice is revoked and replaced with:

- “(2) Agencies responsible for managing and supplying wine analysis functions and activities from 1 July 2007 must be recognised under section 69 of the Wine Act 2003 by 31 December 2007.”

### 4 Interpretation

Clause 4 definition of ‘ISO 17025’ in the principle notice is revoked and replaced with:

“**ISO 17025** refers to the standard NZS ISO/IEC 17025:2005 which is the current edition of the Australian/New Zealand Standard on "General Requirements for the Competence of Testing and Calibration Laboratories", and at any particular time refers to the latest edition of that standard together with any additions, amendments, and deletions made to or from that standard up to that time”

### 5 General requirements for recognition

Sub clause (2)(b) of clause 6 of the principle notice is revoked and replaced with:

- “(2) To maintain its recognition, the recognised agency must-
- (b) be assessed by the accreditation body annually from the date of the recognition to confirm it continues to meet the requirements of ISO 17025, and a copy of the relevant parts of this assessment must be forwarded to the Director-General as soon as practicable; and”
